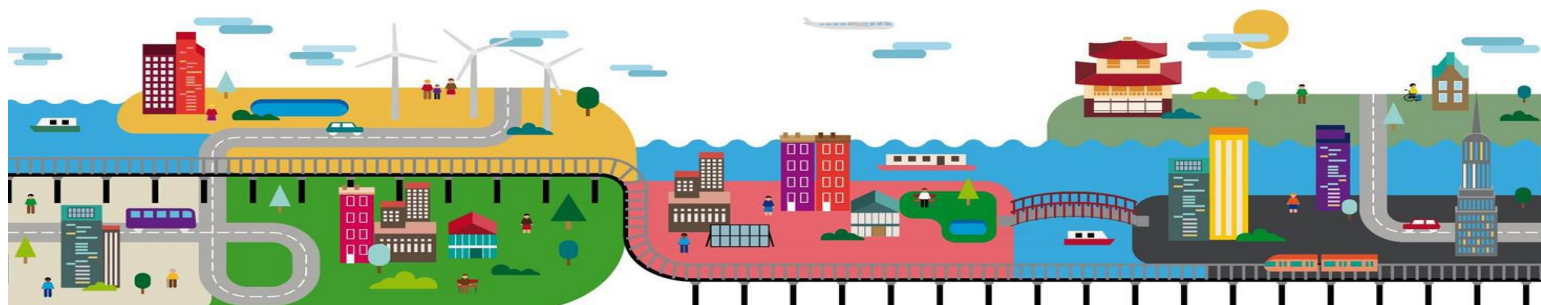

Main <u>objectives</u> of cooperation as described in the U-CAP:	Both cities are interested in the creation of public parks. Araripina pursues the ambition to establish an Open-Air Museum in the Valdomiro Lacerda park.
Short description of main <u>activities</u> and key <u>outputs</u> (e.g. pilot projects):	<p>The cooperation between Santo Tirso and Araripina is focused on rehabilitation of urban areas through sustainable development and recovering of green areas and better quality urban spaces. The action plan is focused on 3 main actions:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Revitalization of urban area to implement green park in Santo Tirso, with the aim of transforming the area in a green park for its population. 2. Strengthening vegetal species in Santo Tirso by implementing spaces to grow plant seedlings in Santo Tirso based on the experience of Araripina; and



	<p>3. Implementation of an Open-Space Museum in Araripina, based on the experience and technical support of Santo Tirso.</p>
<p>Expected results and benefits:</p>	<p>Araripina has been able to develop further its concept for the Valdomiro Lacerda park. During the internship the foundation for the sculpture exhibition was laid, and the sister “sculpture” was finalized. Likewise, in Santo Tirso, the cooperation has contributed to the finalization of the concept for the regeneration of river-side park, an environmental sensitive area of 20.000 sqm.</p>
