History of the Development of Koriyama City -Transition from a city of power generation to city of renewable energy and medical devices-



Oyasuba Burial Mound, built in the early Kofun Period (250 AD-538 AD)



Numagami Hydroelectric Power Station, laid the foundation of Koriyama's development

Great East Japan Earthquake and Nuclear Accident at Fukushima Daiichi Nuclear Power Station in 2011



Building with its first floor collapsed due to the fierce earthquake



Fukushima Renewable Energy Institute, AIST (FREA) opened in April 2014

Restoration from the disasters, promoting renewable energy and medical device development



People gathered, schools and banks established, Fukushima Medical Device Development railroaded to become the center of Fukushima Prefecture

Support Center (FMDDSC) opened in November 2016

- New industry revolution, cotton and chemical industries flourished by hydro electric power generation, Hodogaya Chemical Co., LTD. and Nitto Boseki Co., LTD.
- Modernization by Asaka Canal and Asaka Land Development (1882), paddy rice, silk and carp cultivation flourished
 - Post Station at Oshu Kaido [Edo Period (1603-1868)]






